Overview

Andrew S. MacKay focuses his practice on Intellectual Property enforcement and complex commercial litigation. He has extensive experience representing clients at all stages of litigation, including at trials, appeals, arbitration, and mediation. He serves as the firm's Managing Partner, is the past Co-Chair of the firm's Litigation Practice Group, and is a core member of the firm's Intellectual Property Practice.

He is a leader the firm's IP Enforcement Practice in fields such as:

- Music (such as the internationally renowned "Happy Birthday To You" class action lawsuit, which recovered \$14 million in licensing fees and placed the world's most famous song in the public domain, and the prominent *Wixen Music Publishing, Inc. Spotify* lawsuit on behalf of one of the largest independent music publishing administrators representing over 500 world renowned musical acts, including numerous members of the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame);
- Television and movies (including representing the largest Chinese content producer of online content including television shows and movies);
- Software (including Autodesk, Inc., Adobe Inc., the SIIA, and BSA) and videogames (including Maximum Games, one of the fastest growing woman-owned videogame companies);
- Technology products (such as Dyson, with its revolutionary products such as bladeless fans and hair dryers); and



• Food Products (such as Néstle Dryer's Ice Cream Co., including the Dryer's, HI agen Dazs, and Drumstick).

- OGood Morning to You Productions Corp. et al. v. Warner/Chappell Music, Inc., C.D. Cal. Case No. CV 13-04460 (co-counsel) The "Happy Birthday" class action lawsuit was described by the New York Times as "a lawsuit for the ages." A leader in Donahue Fitzgerald's successful prosecution of plaintiffs' case, which resulted in the Court granting summary judgment on liability in his clients' favor. The Court ruled that Warner/Chappel Music, Inc., one of the world's top music publishers, had no rights to the song after it had collected millions of dollars in royalties from the song for decades. Shortly thereafter, Warner/Chappel Music, Inc. agreed to a settlement that repaid \$14 million in royalties and placed the song "Happy Birthday to You," the world's most popular song, in the public domain.
- Autodesk, Inc. As litigation and IP enforcement co-counsel managed a program combatting online unauthorized distribution of software products in over fifty successful UDRPs, including:

BHN Intl LLC dba Lava Heat Italia et al.*, Case No. C13-4694 (JSC) (Northern District of CA), in which defendants agreed to cease all distribution of bladeless fans

Maximum Games et al.*, Case No. 3:14-cv-05124-JST (Northern District of California), in which plaintiff alleged right of publicity and trademark claims on behalf of General Patton's heirs related to video game; parties entered into confidential settlement after defendant filed anti-SLAPP motion and motion to dismiss.
- Osoftware & Information Industry Association (SIIA) Co-lead intellectual property enforcement counsel for the principal trade association for the software and digital content industry. Work involves enforcement of SIIA members' copyrights in business software products.
